By-law No 2

By-law made pursuant to Article 21 of the Constitution

Election of Honorary Life Members

1 Interpretation

- 1.1 Unless the contrary intention appears, terms used in this By-law have the same meanings given to them in the Memorandum and Articles of Association (Constitution).

2 Purpose

- 2.1 To determine the process of nominating a person to be an Honorary Life Member of the Association.

3 Nomination of Honorary Life Members

- 3.1 A member may nominate a person to be elected to the class of Honorary Life Member pursuant to Article 4.2 of the Constitution.
- 3.2 Each nomination shall be given to the National Secretary in writing at least 28 days before the National Committee meeting at which the nomination is to be considered.
- 3.3 A nomination shall not be considered at a National Committee meeting unless it is supported in writing by the Executive sub-Committee or by a Branch Chairman.
