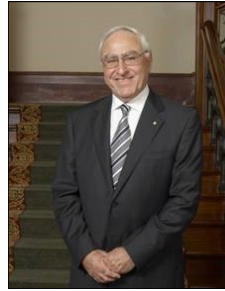
The Western Australian Branch of the Order of Australia Association congratulates you on award within the Order of Australia and on the recognition of your achievements.
